The Shalom project continues to run a variety of programmes to reach out to those affected by HIV within the community.

Home Based Care (HBC) has been a crucial aspect of our project that helps us to reach out to families in need. Over the past few months many of the families involved in HBC have continued to attend the various activities that are conducted by Shalom. The active participation of some of the stabilized families in these activities has helped and encouraged other families that attend, especially the 6 new families that have recently joined the program. The HBC staff have also had the opportunity to speak to

the families about many of the issues they face, specifically in relation to marriage, relationships and children.

Outreach to the youth has also been a focus through our Adolescent Health Education classes. These classes have been running on a regular basis and more and more children are beginning to attend. We are seeking to continually improve the teaching material and as such we currently have a staff member revising and compiling modules for the classes in the hope that we can have a continued positive impact on the children.
